

## **(INT 399) SECOND LANGUAGE ACQUISITION TASHIP**

### **Description**

This 60 hour Community-based course combines coursework with a teaching assistantship in a bilingual primary school. The professional experience will be academically directed, supervised by a UB faculty, and conducting a research project. TAs will work closely with the schoolteacher engaging in school life 12 hours/ week. They will also meet the faculty once a week to discuss both the assignments and the research project. The practical work at the school has two purposes: to get a meaningful insight on how a second language is acquired in childhood, and to gain a critical reflection about the Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL), methodology used in bilingual schools in Buenos Aires.
